

Course description Case studies on Moroccan culture and society (5 ECTs) an online course

A course on social science research in Morocco, with a series of online lectures and films by scholars based in Morocco in disciplines such as sociology, anthropology, history, and political science. The lectures will be offered in the form of a recording or a live stream. Topics include urbanisation, gender, migration, social movements and media. It includes a series of documentaries and films on various sites of cultural interest and social organisations in Morocco. The course readings examine over half a century of modern research on Moroccan culture and society and offer a good overview of the current state of knowledge. The documentaries and films give an insight in the layout of modern Moroccan cities and the countryside and offer an additional in-depth insight in the themes of the online lectures.

- An in-depth understanding of Moroccan society
- Basic knowledge of social studies of Morocco
- Knowledge of the history and current state of knowledge of research on Moroccan culture and society
- Academic writing skills
