

Course description Intensive language instruction Moroccan Arabic (5 ECTs) an online course

The aim of this course is to familiarise students with Moroccan Arabic (Darija), the spoken language of Morocco, with online workgroup sessions. The course provides students with basic grammar and vocabulary in order to practice their speaking skills in Moroccan Arabic. Theory and exercises are taken from "The Routledge Introductory Course in Moroccan Arabic: An Introductory Course" by Jan Hoogland, the handbook for this course.

Course objectives

Students are expected to be able to express themselves and take part in conversations on topics of everyday life such as personal identification, living and housing, and food.
